Campaign blows past 2014 goal and exceeds 2013 giving!

The Greater North Carolina Combined Federal Campaign (GNCACFC) “blew” right past its 2014 goal of \$1,325,000 raising a grand total of **\$1,393,644.05!** This is an increase of **1%** or **\$10,577** in NEW contributions.

Interesting facts you might like to know:

- We had **4,247** donors in 2014 vs. 4,184 in 2013
- Research Triangle Area employees raised an *outstanding* **\$696,652.24** in 2014 vs. the \$649,282.18 raised in 2013 - an increase of **7.3%** with **\$47,370.06** in NEW donations!!!
- Employees at 26 Social Security offices donated a total of **\$89,293** in 2014 vs. 20 offices donating \$58,447 in 2013 - an increase of **34.4%** - WOW!!!!
- Credit card donations are on the rise with **\$23,876** from 101 donors in 2014 - this compares to \$15,734 from 100 donors in 2013
- Employees at the NC Air National Guard in Charlotte have **more than doubled** their giving in the past three years - \$9,629 in 2012 to a record **\$21,371** in 2014!!!! What a terrific job!
- In Greensboro, employees at the USPS Processing & Distribution Center contributed **\$49,180.17** in 2014 vs. the \$35,696.74 in 2013 - a **37.77%** increase is a lot to be proud about!

Congratulations to the outstanding groups listed above and to ALL employees!

10 years of 100% giving!

Customs and Border Protection in Greensboro marked its 10th consecutive year of 100% donating to CFC! Each year, Steve Bowie, keyworker, is the **first** to return pledge forms - and each employee has given!

When asked how he has been able to achieve 100% giving for so many years, he said “we have great people here at Customs & Border Patrol who want to see CFC succeed in helping others”. Since 2011, donations have increased by 33% - an increase of \$130. Doesn’t sound like much? This is what \$130 *can do* for a charity:

- Provide Parent Educator’s assistance to 5 families to help improve a disabled child’s education
- Give an opportunity for a child to learn a valuable life-saving skill and a life-long, healthy activity

821% Increase in 3 years!!!!

NO - that is the increase that **LeeAnn Williams**, USPS Loaned Executive, has achieved since 2012!!! Here’s a little breakdown of her accomplishments:

- 22 postal facilities in 2012 raised \$10,008.78
- In 2013, **44** postal facilities raised \$56,127.96
- In 2014, with three years under her belt and a fierce determination to succeed, LeeAnn’s **59** postal facilities raised a record **\$92,252.50** - an **821%** increase!!!!

Hats off and kudos to LeeAnn for her fantastic success! She ensured each post office had a charity speaker and asked every employee to give. Hard work and focus paid off for her and for all the charities CFC represents! Job well done LeeAnn!!!
